
- Over 1500 hours of training for over 400 youth service professionals and over 150 summer program workers*

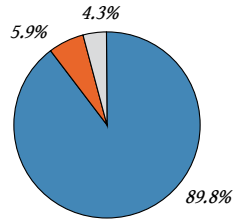

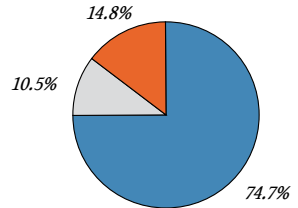
