EARLY INTERVENTION PLANNING COUNCIL (EIPC)

EIPC was established by City-County Ordinance in 2005. The purpose of EIPC is to establish a plan for early intervention and prevention for children and families at risk of entering the child welfare or delinquency system. EIPC oversees the EIP Initiative. EIPC selected MCCOY to manage the EIP Initiative in 2009.

The mission of EIP is to eliminate child abuse, neglect and juvenile delinquency through comprehensive community efforts that coordinate, build capacity, and advocate for high-quality early intervention and prevention services in Marion County.

Advocacy & Awareness

Ensure that prevention and early intervention programs are available and accessible to youth, individuals and families.

- Engage City-County Councillors and state congressional leaders.
- Conduct an annual survey to identify priority areas.
- Participate in Commission on Improving the Status of Children.

Family Access Network

Promote healthy children, families and communities by increasing access, use and capacity of existing services through innovative, neighborhood-based partnerships in a single location.
