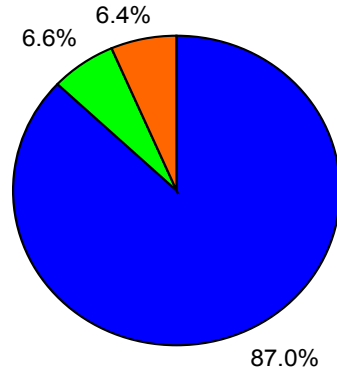


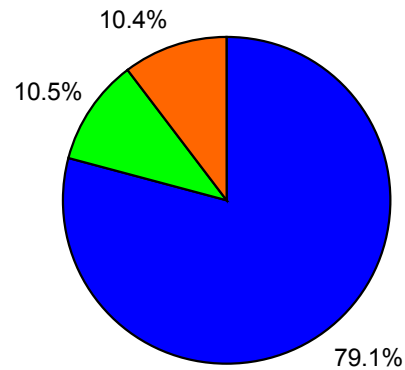

Dear Friends of MCCOY,

For more than 17 years, MCCOY has been in the forefront of efforts to provide every one of our young people the resources and supports needed to become prepared for adulthood as productive and responsible citizens. We accomplish these ideals through leadership on key issues, support of the youth worker community and serving as a resource, advocate, capacity builder and convener.

In 2009, MCCOY was chosen to be the coordinating agency for the Early Intervention and Prevention initiative, a new program designed to reduce the number of youth and their families that become involved with our juvenile court and child welfare system. MCCOY continued its efforts with the national Quality Counts – Ready by 21 program, rolling out the Youth Program Quality Assessment process with 12 participating youth-serving agencies. The Learning Network continued to provide high quality, low cost training and workshops to over 150 youth working professionals representing over 100 local agencies. Over 250 individuals participated in MCCOY's Summit for Student Success in July of 2009, which educated attendees on the issue of drop-out prevention and inspired them to advocate for community participation in plans to increase high school graduation rates.

MCCOY also:

- Distributed more than 25,000 copies of the Youth Activity Directory (YAD)
- Distributed more than 15,000 copies of the Essential Aid & Services for You (EASY) Book
- Grew *Allied for Youth*, a youth issues online social networking site, membership by 140
