INDIANAPOLIS – The Marion County Commission on Youth, Inc. (MCCOY) has recently moved to office spaces at 1375 W. 16th St. in Indianapolis.

MCCOY’s new location include offices for staff, as well as training and conference rooms that will be used to carry out the organization’s role as a convener and intermediary for other groups that help children and teens in Marion County.

“This transition allows our team to expand further into central Indianapolis and take advantage of a new set of resources that can be used to benefit the youth of our city,” said John Brandon, president of MCCOY.

The move comes after more than twenty years as a tenant in the United Way of Central Indiana’s Meridian Street building, which is being sold by the owner.
