



MORNING EVENTS

- 9:00 AM** **Check-in begins**
Follow signs to the MCCOY check-in desk in the north atrium on the 2nd (ground level) floor. Here you will collect your materials and resources for the day.
- 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM** **Youth Advocacy Resource Fair**
Youth advocacy groups from around the state representing diverse interests will be available throughout the morning in the north atrium for you to meet. Learn about the work they do to empower youth and see how you can become a part of the action!
- 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM** **Committee hearings**
Throughout the morning, House and Senate committees will be meeting. Locations and committee schedules will be provided to you at check-in. Watch committee discussions, listen to public testimony, and hear arguments in support and opposition of some of this year's legislation.

Guides with the Indiana Statehouse Tour office will offer a tour of the historic building. This in-depth tour covers the history of the building and the state, architectural information about the building, and the workings of state government. The full Senate will meet in the Senate Chamber. Watch state senators discuss legislation and vote on bills from the Senate Gallery, which is located on the 4th floor. No food or drinks are permitted.
